### **For Immediate Release:**

On December 23, 2013, at approximately 12:23 a.m. Gibson County Central Dispatch received a call about an older model truck sitting behind the Buckskin Fire Department. The caller was not sure if the vehicle was supposed to be there, but stated that they would like to have an officer check it out. Once officers arrived on scene a female who was later identified as Amber R. Reiner age 19 of the Rural Oakland City attempted to flee the scene. Deputy Bryan Small began to investigate the incident, and during the course of the investigation it was discovered that officers had interrupted a B&E in that was in progress. Deputy Small was able to recover a 2 inch water meter, a 5 inch water meter, 4 brass nozzles, and other miscellaneous scrap metal that totaled in value of over \$1150. At the close of the roadside investigation Ms. Reiner was transported to the Gibson County Jail where she was charged with Theft and Breaking in and Entering. She remains in custody at the Gibson County Jail.

Also during the course of this investigation Ruth M. Robling, age 36 of Rural Oakland City was arrested by Francisco Town Marshal Mike McGregor. Ms. Robling was transported to the Gibson County Sheriff's Office where she was charged with Possession of Methamphetamines. Ms. Robling remains in custody on a \$750 bond.
